### **Holy Spirit on the Airwaves**



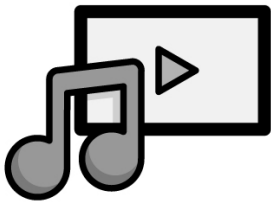
To broadcast therapeutic music to those who need peace, rest and healing.

To be a tool for people to find Jesus and receive Bible Studies.



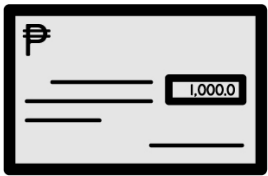

# Operation and Costs

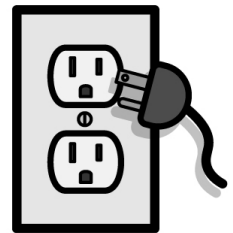
FINANCIAL/OPERATIONAL FOUNDATIONS



## **Funded by Donors**

VLMI has the option of pulling out a station and returning it to donors and, shutting down a station if any part of this agreement is not upheld.

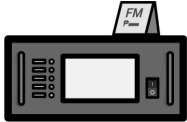

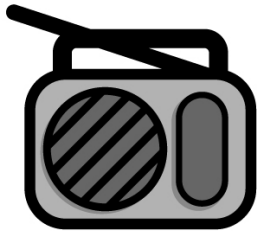

### Provided Flash Drive/Hard Drive

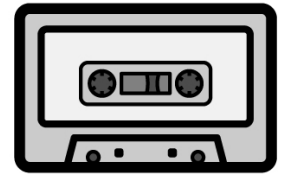
Hard Disc Drive / Flash Drive from Donated PC to be pre-programmed by VLMI / HCBN

Only Non-commercial activities and announcements will be made.

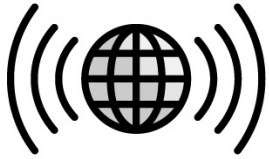
Feedback mechanisms will as well be answered in recorded format.

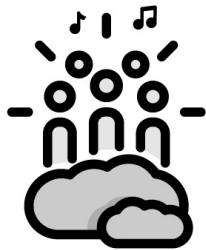
All programs prepared by VLMI stations will be recorded and shared with VLMI mother station so all sister stations can rebroadcast in their areas.

### **All Programs Shared Globally**

Broadcasting ethics will be observed at all times.



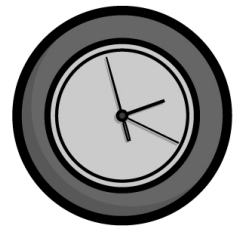
## **Broadcasting Ethics**



Programs are for presentation purposes only. Because of music licensing reasons, at no time should the supplied music be used for anything outside of broadcasting. Personal use is also strictly prohibited unless they are open files already.

## **Presentation Purposes Only**

Except in cases of prolonged power outage, the transmitter must be in operation 24/7.

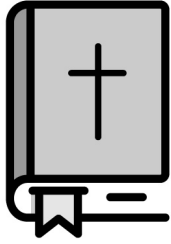

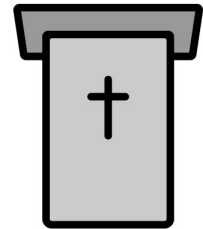
## PROGRAMS AND CONTENT



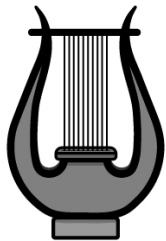
Minimum of 3 to 5-minute advocacy tips on Health, Mental Health, Family, Youth, will be played every other hour.

During office hours, heavenly music will be played.

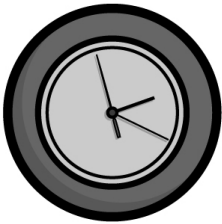

# Duties and Practices

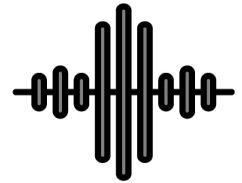
## STATION OPERATION RESPONSIBILITIES



Make sure the transmitter runs 24/7 as long as power is available.

### **Continuous Broadcasting**

Inform VLMI / HCBN and Communications Engineer and Supplier of Transmitter ASAP if there is any splatter detected.



### **No Radio “Splatter”**



Turn off the transmitter as soon as there are complaints of splatter.

### **Turn Off if “Splattering”**

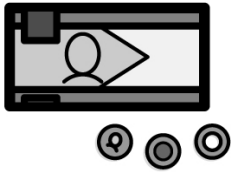


## PURPOSE OF THE STATION

Inform the Supplier of Transmitter and VLMI as soon as splatter has been detected.

### **Monthly and Yearly Costs**

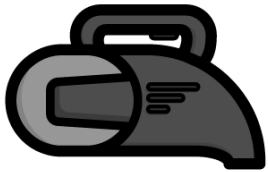
Secure the Tower and Antenna at all times.
